Dear school community,

Our school has been advised of members of our school community who have tested positive to COVID-19. We continue to have reasonably small numbers of COVID positive students in Years 7-12 in our Special Education and Mainstream settings as well as the recent addition of 2 staff members. We are however, asking that parents and carers of students in Year 8 Mainstream be especially vigilant and monitor for even the mildest of symptoms and a consider administering a Rapid Antigen Test.

We thank our staff, students and families for the diligence being applied to Rapid Antigen testing when symptomatic and for letting us know of positive results.

While testing and isolation is no longer mandatory for exposures in schools following exposure to COVID-19, <u>we advise that you continue to undertake Rapid Antigen</u> <u>testing if symptomatic</u>. You are reminded that staff and students cannot attend school if they are showing any symptoms of COVID-19. These include fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting, extreme tiredness, unexplained chest pain or conjunctivitis (eye infection).

If symptoms occur at any time, you should not attend school and should undertake a rapid antigen test. If a rapid antigen test is positive your child should isolate, along with all household members for 7 days and only return to school when symptoms have gone. If you cannot access a rapid antigen test, you can attend a PCR (nose and throat swab) testing clinic. <u>Please inform us of the positive result.</u>
